INGREDIENTS

2 cups fresh blueberries
1 cup peeled and diced fresh peaches
1 small cucumber, peeled and diced
½ cup finely diced red onion
1 jalapeno, seeded and finely chopped
2 Tablespoons chopped flat leaf Italian parsley
1 Tablespoon chopped chives or tarragon
Zest of ½ lime
3 Tablespoons freshly squeezed lime juice
1-2 Tablespoons olive or grape seed oil
Salt & pepper to taste

PREPARATION

Place blueberries, peaches and cucumber in bowl of a food processor and pulse 4-5 times. Add remaining ingredients and pulse once or twice just to combine. Do not puree.

Pour into serving bowl and chill for several hours. Serve as a sauce on grilled meat or fish, or as a dip with corn chips. Chef's Note: Substitute other local seasonal ingredients for the blueberries—such as peaches, blackberries or red raspberries—to make this healthy and delicious salsa throughout the growing season!
