## Summer Fruit Salsa

Courtesy of Chef Jackie Blevins of Perfectly Seasoned (Makes about 3 cups)

### INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups fresh blueberries
- 1 cup peeled and diced fresh peaches
- 1 small cucumber, peeled and diced
- ½ cup finely diced red onion
- 1 jalapeno, seeded and finely chopped
- 2 Tablespoons chopped flat leaf Italian parsley
- 1 Tablespoon chopped chives or tarragon
- Zest of ½ lime
- 3 Tablespoons freshly squeezed lime juice
- 1-2 Tablespoons olive or grape seed oil
- Salt & pepper to taste

### PREPARATION

Place blueberries, peaches and cucumber in bowl of a food processor and pulse 4-5 times. Add remaining ingredients and pulse once or twice just to combine. Do not puree. Pour into serving bowl and chill for several hours. Serve as a sauce on grilled meat or fish, or as a dip with corn chips. **Chef's Note:** Substitute other local seasonal ingredients for the blueberries—such as peaches, blackberries or red raspberries—to make this healthy and delicious salsa throughout the growing season!
